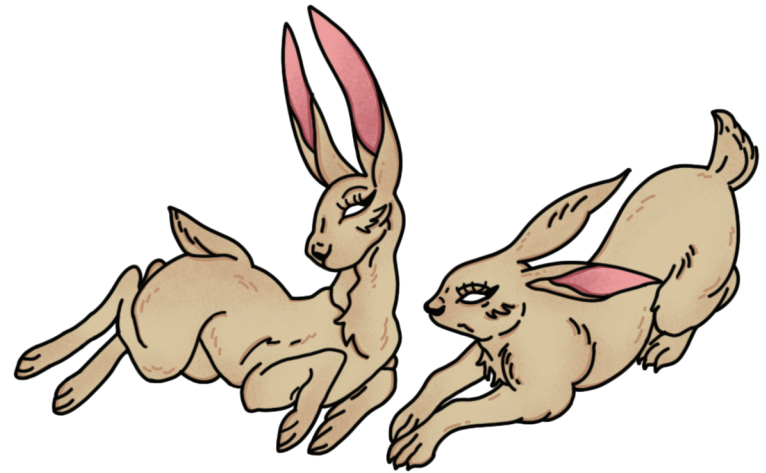

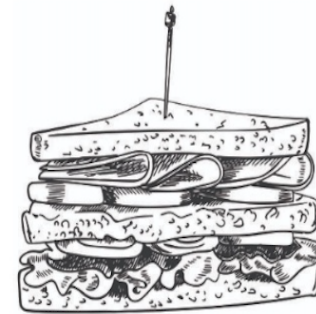

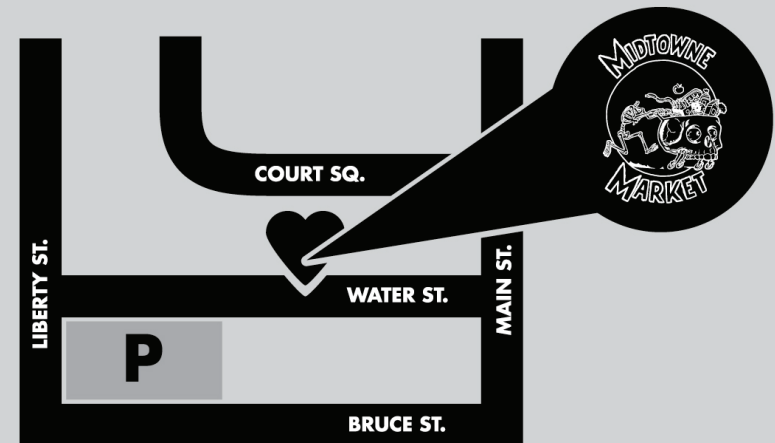

# Info

## History

MACROCK was founded in 1996 as an arm of WXJM, James Madison University's student-run radio station, before severing ties in the mid-2000's. Since then, a small group of volunteers organize annually to plan, fundraise, and coordinate the event in venues across downtown Harrisonburg. Our panel series serves as a conversational platform on which topics, spanning everything from gear nerd indulgences to the present socio-political atmosphere, are addressed amongst a diverse group of panelists. Our expo hosts independent record labels and radio stations, local artisans, zinesters, authors, and collectors. MACROCK is a non-profit organization and would be impossible without the help of countless volunteers, artists, local businesses, and residents. We cannot express how much we appreciate you and everything you do.

## Listening Procedure

Each year, most of the artists that play MACROCK apply to do so. This year we opened digital applications for the third time ever, in which bands sent a 3 song demo. During the first round of listening, we play each demo and give it a score out of 5 before we have even looked at the artist's name. If a committee member knows the artist, they abstain from voting. Applications with a high enough score go on to the second round in which they are narrowed down and matched to showcases based on genre, how much we like their music, and, to a small degree, draw. We got over 420 applications this year and it's very difficult to make our final decisions. We appreciate each and every band that applies, this festival needs you!

MACROCK is an annual DIY music festival and conference located in Harrisonburg, VA. Organized by a small group of volunteers, MACROCK exists as a celebration of independent music and do-it-yourself culture. MACROCK is perpetuated by the belief that staying an active, supportive part of the local community will preserve and stimulate art free of corporate influence.

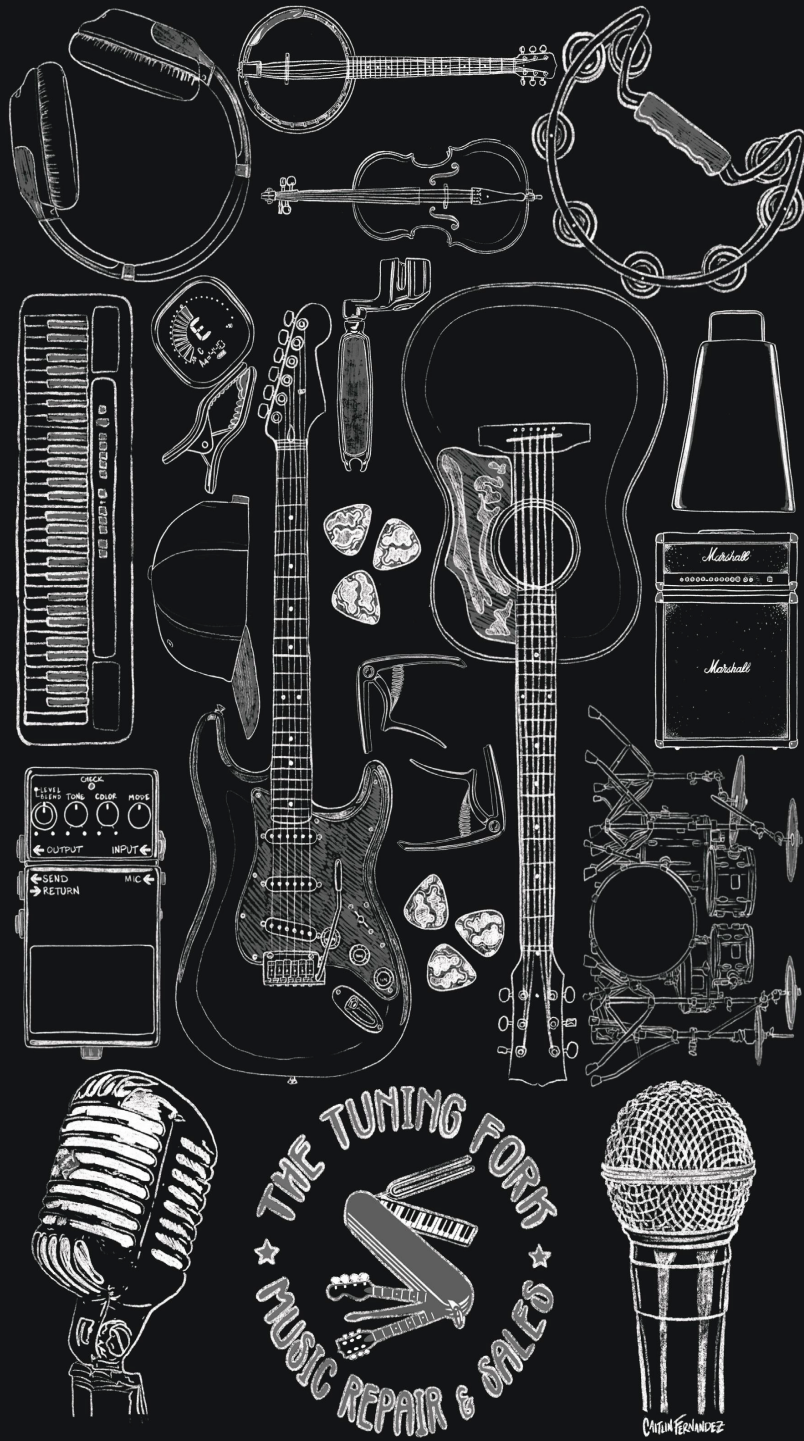

## Reminder

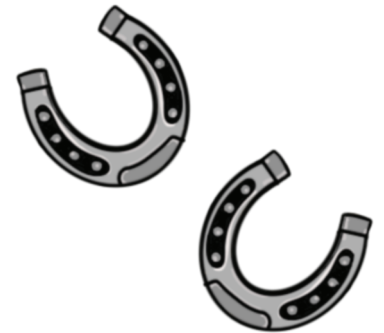
No backpacks or cameras (personal photos are okay!) are allowed in the venue unless given explicit permission by the MACROCK committee in the form of a press pass!

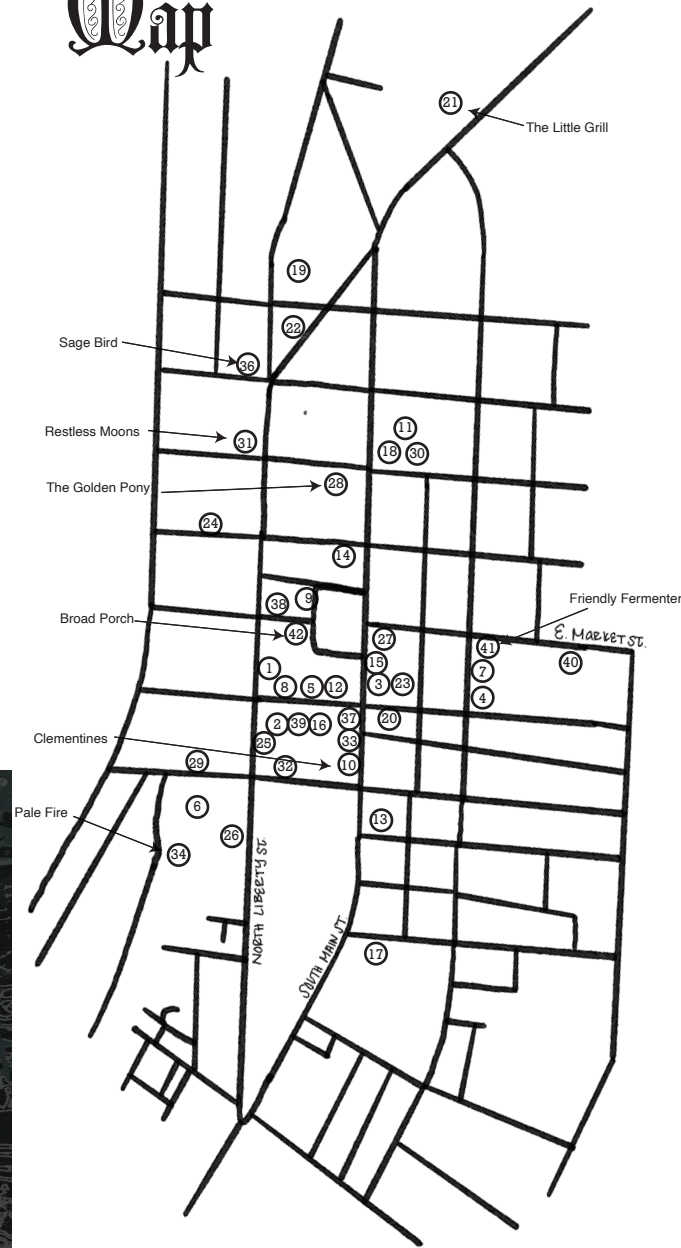

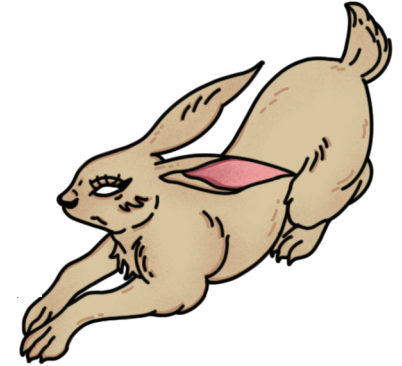

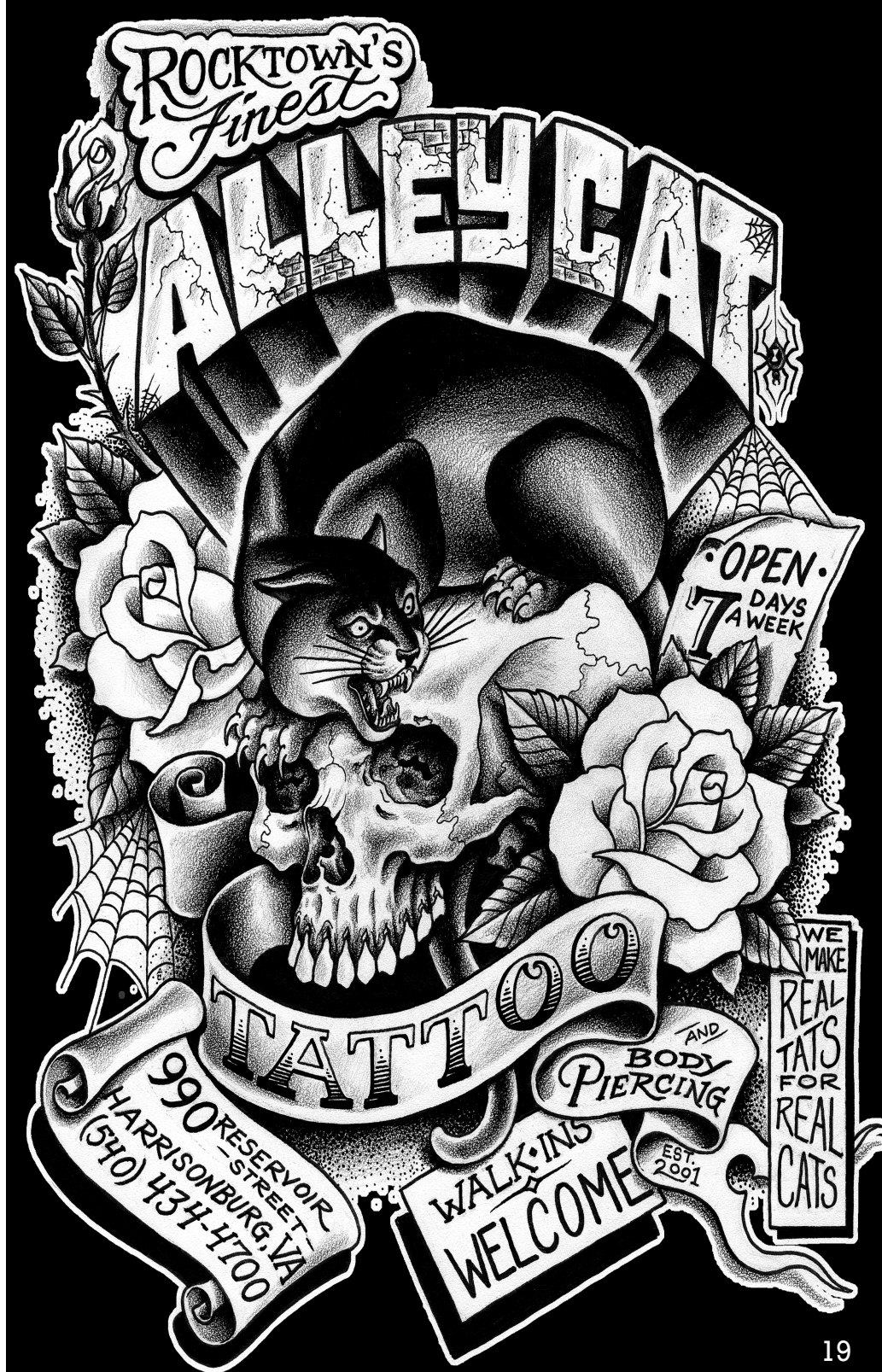
